

GOD'S PERSPECTIVE ON WOMANHOOD

In this video we are looking at God's perspective on womanhood. We will look at the feminist narrative and see if it is at all reconcilable with biblical teachings or whether we need to revisit it altogether. So is there a place for a woman in society or was she always an afterthought? What about a woman's rights in marriage, submission and gender equality?

Gender related issues and feminist ideologues need to be approached with wisdom and sensitivity.

This will help many with this troubling dialogue of gender equality, domestic order, women rights, equality before God and biblical virtue

Key thoughts in this sermon:

1. Our help comes from the Lord. Psalm 50:4 "the Lord has become my help." God is our help. So when you look at the term "help" and attribute it to the woman. It is in no way undermining her. It is in no way reducing her humanity. If anything else, it is giving her a godly attribute.
2. At the fall of man, God brought forth the current domestic order so that the plan of redemption, He said that the woman will now submit to the men. Submission is a good thing, but there is something better than submission or oneness, because before the fall we don't read about anyone submitting to another person.
3. Submission was institutionalized to remedy the effect of the fall. But there is a place greater, a place called the simplicity of Oneness. Because before the fall there was no need for superiority or heirachy, any selfish attitude like that who are swallowed up in the simplicity of unity.
