Equal but different

Key pointers:

1. Headship is a matter of authority for the purpose of serving. So the man is the head and it gives him authority so that he can serve as he leads the household. Right. So this is servant leadership. So just like Jesus, Jesus is over his enemies, but in front of the church, He is the head He leads, but he is over his enemies.
2. It is not positional authority. Neither is it a titular authority. But authority in this sense, is servant leadership for the purposes of serving, not to be preeminent but, authority is given because of the function to serve and lead. That's headship. So let us look at it in its proper perspective.
